Dear Parents,

This week we are supporting “The Feed the Babies” organisation. Sandy Davies from the organisation, spoke to the learners in assembly, explaining how the money collected goes towards feeding less fortunate children. The learners were asked to participate in chores around their homes and to collect money, which they would then donate. In class it provides an opportunity for the learners to recognise the various coins and notes. Graphs are drawn to compare the daily totals. Thank you, in advance, for supporting our first term outreach programme.

Last year, Mrs Rijmsmus collected 10 bread bags full of “bread tags” which would go towards sponsoring a wheelchair for an underprivileged person. She will continue with this initiative and will welcome all collected tags.

Hoping that the weather co-operates, to ensure a fun filled evening. The Tuck shop will be open.
