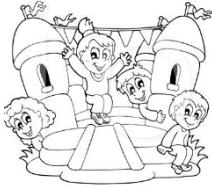

Mrs Basford, will be in charge of the inflatables and will be directing parents to areas that need to be monitored. She will be found under the school gazebo.
